### Are You Eligible?

Applicants need to be -

- Committed to Scotland's journey to net zero
- A Scotland-based SME with a turnover or investment of over £100k
- In the green/low carbon, digital or health sectors (preferred but not essential)
- Plan to grow their turnover to £2M - £3M+ within 3-5 years
- Able to create new, good and green jobs for Scotland
- Committed to developing their leadership skills

### Background

The prestigious Unlocking Ambition Challenge is a flagship entrepreneurial development fund, initiated by the First Minister for Scotland and delivered by Scottish Enterprise. It supports ambitious entrepreneurs from across Scotland, chosen for their individual potential, the quality of their ideas and the contribution they can make to the environment, the economy and wider society.

Successful applicants will receive wrap-around support from Scottish Enterprise and their partners. Each company will have access to the Unlocking Ambition Development Fund, business advice support and an 8-month programme of world-class executive education.
